Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 17 of which not more than 4 sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 for a classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Some classrooms of the school are below 500 sq feet. Hence the school is directed to restrict student's enrolment upto 32 in each section for the classroom of below 500 sq ft. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension. The school is directed to run atleast 01 section each of bal-vatika I, II & III in accordance with established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
2	Storage facility is not adequate in any of the lab. The existing workstation of the lab should be changed with permanent workstation with inbuilt utilities for Chemistry and Biology section and lab standard permanent table for Physics section. More apparatus/equipment need sto be added in all the lab. Thus, the school is required to update the entire lab as per Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
3	Math lab is a temporary arrangement, with equipment is displayed on tables and no proper workstations. No storage is seen. Thus, the school is required to update the lab as per Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.

4	The books in the Library are poorly managed and there is no separate reading space for staff. Thus, the school is required to update the library as per Board's SoP and submit the compliance within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	Fiber chairs in computer lab are inappropriate The school should provide for computer chairs/straight back upholstered chairs for students seating as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
6	School is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time and upload under MPD of its website in all the times including NOC, Recognition/Land/Building Safety/Fire Safety/Society Registration/Water & Sanitation Certificate etc. and submit compliance on SARAS Portal.
7	School has obtained Fire Safety Certificate for one Block only whereas school has two block. Hence, school is required to obtain fresh Fire Safety Certificate for all the block and floor and submit compliance on SARAS Portal.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Patna within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye - Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
